This is notification of our policy in dealing with all information which we hold for you.

We are committed to protecting your privacy. We comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and follow strict security measures in the storage and disclosure of information that you have given to us to prevent unauthorised access.

What Information do we collect about You?

What do we do with the Information

- Only keep the information whilst you are a Member (or as long as is necessary).
- We do not share information with third parties for commercial purposes.
